### Plymouth County Employee Covid/vaccination policy discussion

Administrator Basler gave an update on the status of Federal and State vaccination policies. Commissioner Valanzola made a motion to approve a stipend of \$200.00 per person for all vaccinated employees. Commissioner Wright seconded. Vote: The motion passed unanimously

Register of Deeds Buckley stated he supports a mandate by October 28<sup>th</sup>.
